Medicare regulations provide that advance written notice be given to a beneficiary regarding the possible denial of Medicare payment for services for which the beneficiary will be held liable for payment. Under section 1862(a)(1) of the Medicare law, Medicare will only pay for services that it determines to be "reasonable and necessary" under Medicare program standards and/or section 1862(a)(7) which excludes routine physical examinations. If Medicare determines that a particular service is not covered under the Medicare program standards, Medicare will deny payment for that service.

Certain examinations are denied because your insurance company determined it to be Not Medically Necessary or the referring Physician did Not Obtaining Prior Certification or Authorization under your insurance company's program standards. Your insurance company can and may deny payment for certain procedures. Some of the reasons for denial are listed below.

MRI Procedures: MRI/MRA without having a abnormal lower cost procedure. Multiple procedures on the same day, Bilateral Lower Extremities, and any procedure repeated within a six (6) months on the same body part. MRI Procedures order by a Chiropractor.

CT Procedures: CTA, Coronary Artery Calcification Scoring, Bone Density, Virtual Colonoscopy, and any procedure repeated within a six (6) months of the same body part or deemed to be for the purpose of screening.

Ultrasound Procedures: Vascular imaging repeated within a six (6) month period,

General Diagnostic Procedures: Routine or Pre-Operative Chest X-Rays, Spinal Injections for Pain Management.

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This waiver is to make you aware of the fact that your insurance company can deny payment for a multitude of reasons. A few are listed above, however depending upon your plan your insurance company can and, may deny payment based on the coverage of your policy. We do not know until your insurance company is billed. Insurance companies do not guarantee payment until they have received your claim.

If your claim is denied, Parkview Imaging will appeal all denied claims. After the appeal process, if the claim is still denied we will bill you for the procedure.

I realize that Parkview Imaging will make every attempt to collect payment from my insurance, but if denied, I agree to be personally and fully responsible for payment.
